

Ambulance Replacement Criteria

I. SCOPE / PURPOSE

The following document offers guidelines for replacing ambulances that are used for patient transport.

II. POLICY

When the odometer reading on an Armstrong Ambulance Vehicle used for the transportation of patients reaches an odometer reading of 220,000 miles, the vehicle will be removed from daily usage and reassigned to "Second Line" status. Vehicles reassigned to "Second Line" status are to be used as temporary replacements when "First Line" vehicles are taken out of service for any reason.

In addition to mileage review, the vehicle maintenance records will be reviewed quarterly to determine if a vehicle needs to be replaced.

Armstrong Ambulance vehicles may be replaced or reassigned at any time prior to meeting the above criteria at the discretion of the President, CEO and Fleet Maintenance Manager.
