I. SCOPE / PURPOSE

- A. The purpose of Armstrong Ambulance's policy on community education is to advise and educate the public and other public safety agencies on injury prevention and pre-hospital medicine issues.
- B. This policy pertains to all personnel.

II. POLICY

- A. Armstrong Ambulance works with the local communities to provide education on multiple topics, including out-of-hospital care, health promotion and injury prevention. This is achieved through working with the local schools, police departments, fire departments, parks and recreation departments and healthcare facilities.
- B. Armstrong offers several community education programs; including but not exclusive to Basic Cardiac Life Support training, Emergency Medical Dispatch Awareness programs, courses on Airborne Pathogens and Bloodborne Pathogens, etc.

III. PROCEDURE

Armstrong Ambulance handles all requests for community education in the following manner.

1. All pertinent information must be gathered regarding the request.
 - a. Type of education requested
 - b. Location, date, and time of request
 - c. Availability of Armstrong's Education Resources
2. Information is to be forwarded to the Director of Clinical Services for consideration.
3. A decision will be made no more than two days after the request.

IV. RESPONSIBILITY

The Director of Clinical Services is responsible for overseeing the Education Department and authorizing resources for requests and any changes or updates to the Community Education policies, procedures, and programs.
